

A regular Auburn city council meeting was held on the 11th day of January 2021 in the basement of City Hall. Mayor Richard Heim called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm with a roll call vote as following; Rick Carlyle, Cindy Finley, Jane Barto, Randy Schulte, and Robert Theulen.

A motion was made by Councilor Finley and seconded by Councilor Barto approving the consent agenda including agenda, minutes from the December 14th, 2020 council meeting, approval of new Fire Department Officers Fire Chief – Joe Sievers and Asst.
