

ORDINANCE NO. 22-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, AND TRANSIENT MERCHANTS

Be It Enacted by the City Council of the City of Auburn, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SUBSECTION ADDED. Section 122.17 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Auburn, Iowa, is amended by adding a new subsection which is hereby adopted to read as follows:

7. Minor Businesses. An on-site transactional business traditionally operated exclusively by a person under the age of 18, operated on an occasional basis for no more than 89 calendar days in a calendar year.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 364.3[13])

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
