Approval of FY 23 Maximum Property Tax Dollars

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Auburn have considered the proposed FY 23 city maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total, and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars was published as required and posted on city web site and/or social media accounts if applicable,
